

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many chaperones do I need?

RYM does not have a chaperone/student ratio requirement; please use your judgment, as you know your students better than we do. However, **a good rule of thumb is a 1:6 chaperone to student ratio.**

Can chaperones bring children along?

No, no exceptions.

Do I need a male & a female chaperone?

If you are bringing both males & females, you need a male & female chaperone.

Can I request a certain room?

No.

Can I request to room with another group?

Yes. However, we can make no guarantees since housing is tight.

Can I make changes to my registration list? What about late fees?

Yes. You may exchange students/chaperones on your list. However, after the housing is set, you may only exchange a male student/chaperone for another male, and a female for another female. Please e-mail all changes to kfriedman@rymonline.org.

Exchanging students/chaperones will not incur a late fee. However, any additional registrations received after May 14, 2012 **will** incur a \$25 per person late fee.

What about folks who drop out? Is my church still responsible for their spots?

Yes, once you have secured spots with \$100/person deposits, your church is responsible for those spots. You may find another person to take a dropped spot. If you are unable to find replacements for attendees who drop out before June 11, 2012, you will lose their \$100 deposits. If a student/chaperone drops out after June 11 (one week before camp), you will lose the full amount of his/her tuition.

TIPS FOR FIRST TIMERS

Arrival: What to do and where to go

Registration begins at 3:00 pm on Monday, June 11th. You will not be able to register early. When you arrive at the YMCA of the Rockies, follow the signs to registration. Please send no more than TWO youth leaders/chaperones into the room where you will register your group. Students who have not signed up online for electives should do so upon arrival after you have registered your group. Dinner will be served at 5:00 at Reusch Dining Hall.

Small Group Time

Each night following worship there will be a designated small group time where you will lead your own students in follow-up questions/discussion relating to the evening's sermon. Each person planning to lead a small group will want to take notes during the sermons to aid in discussion. There will also be devotional time in the morning designed for students to have personal quiet time. RYM will provide small group questions and devotional materials for the week.
